NOTICE OF RACE

The notation '[NP]' in a rule means that a boat may not protest another boat for breaking that rule. This changes RRS 60.1(a).

1 RULES

- 1.1 The event is governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.
- 1.2 If there is a conflict between languages the English text takes precedence.

2 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

- 2.1 The sailing instructions will be available on or before 1700h on July 22, 2021 at Kingston Yacht Club or on-line at www.kingstonyachtclub.com/foilkingston2021.

3 COMMUNICATION

- 3.1 The online official notice board is located at www.kingstonyachtclub.com/foilkingston2021.
- 3.2 [DP] While racing, except in an emergency, a competitor shall not make voice or data transmissions and shall not receive voice or data communication that is not available to all competitors.

4 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 4.1 The event is open to all foiling boards, foiling multihulls and foiling dinghies.
- 4.2 A minimum of 4 boats makes a class. Expected one design classes include A class, F18, iQfoil (open), Moth and WASZP.
- 4.3 The organizing authority reserves the right to group similar boats together to form one or more classes.
- 4.4 Competitors may enter the event by registering online at www.kingstonyachtclub.com/foilkingston2021.
- 4.5 Each competitor under 18 years of age must submit a completed PARENT/GUARDIAN DECLARATION prior to racing. The declaration can be found at www.kingstonyachtclub.com/foilkingston2021.
- 4.6 To be considered an entry in the event, a competitor shall complete all registration requirements and pay all fees.
- 4.7 Registration may be limited depending upon the restrictions placed upon the event by the COVID-19 pandemic.

5 FEES

- 5.1 Entry fee is \$165 CAD (plus HST) single-handed, \$225 (plus HST) double-handed.
\$100 (plus HST) for WASZP Race Clinic
\$150 (plus HST) for A-Class/F18 Race Clinic

6 ADVERTISING

- 6.1 Competitors may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the organizing authority.

7 SCHEDULE

7.2 Five races per day are scheduled. The race committee may run two extra races each day provided the event is not more than one race ahead of schedule.

7.3 On the last scheduled day of racing no warning signal will be made after 1500 hrs.

8 VENUE

8.1 Sailing for windfoilers will race out of Lake Ontario Park. Other classes will race out of Portsmouth Olympic Harbour.

9 COURSES

9.1 The course to be sailed will be windward/leeward. Individual classes may opt to use a different course configuration.

10 PENALTY SYSTEM

10.1 RRS 44.1 is changed so that the Two-Turns Penalty is replaced by the One-Turn Penalty.

11 SCORING

11.1 One race is required to be completed to constitute a series.

- 11.2** (a) When fewer than six races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.
- (b) When six to nine races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.
- (c) When 10 to 15 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her two worst scores.

12 DATA PROTECTION

12.1 By participating in the event, competitors grant to the organizing authority and their sponsors the right in perpetuity to make, use and show, from time to time at their discretion, any photography, audio and video recordings, or other reproductions of them made at the venue or on the water from the time of their arrival at the venue, until their final departure, without compensation.

13 RISK STATEMENT

13.1 RRS 3 states: 'The responsibility for a boat's decision to participate in a race or to continue to race is hers alone.' By participating in this event each competitor agrees and acknowledges that sailing is a potentially dangerous activity with inherent risks. These risks include strong winds and rough seas, sudden changes in weather, failure of equipment, handling errors, poor seamanship by other competitors, loss of balance on an unstable platform and fatigue resulting in increased risk of injury.

14 INSURANCE

14.1 Each participating kiteboard shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of \$2,000,000 CAD per incident or the equivalent.

15 PRIZES

15.1 Prizes will be given to boats placing first, second and third in each class with five or more entries; to those placing first and second in classes with four entries and to the first place in classes with three entries.

15.2 Other prizes may be awarded.

16 CONCUSSION AWARENESS

16.1 [DP] Certain aspects of Rowan's Law are in effect. To review current information and requirement, check the Ontario Sailing website: <https://ontariosailing.ca/concussion-information/>

16.2 [DP] Any participant who registers with or enters an event, needs to do the following:

- Confirm you have read a Ministry Approved Concussion Awareness Resource.
- Confirm you have reviewed, and committed to, the Ontario Sailing Athlete Concussion Code of Conduct.

16.3 [DP] Coaches/Instructors need to also complete both items below.

- Confirm they have read a Ministry Approved Concussion Awareness Resource.
- Confirm they have reviewed, and committed to, the Ontario Sailing Coach Concussion Code of Conduct.
