NOTICE OF RACE

The Organizing Authority is: Kingston Yacht Club

1. Rules

The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing 2017-2020*.

2. Eligibility and Entry

- 2.1 The regatta is open to all boats of the 2.4mR Class.
- 2.2 Eligible boats may enter by completing the registration form and emailing it to Kingston Yacht Club at:

2.3 Measurement forms and safety equipment may be verified at Regatta Check-in.

3. Fee

- a) The entry fee before July 1 2019 is \$225.00, plus HST Canadian Funds.
- b) The Late entry fee from July 1 2019 is \$250.00, plus HST Canadian Funds.

The price includes two full breakfasts one dinner at KYC. Extra breakfast, dinner and meal package tickets will be available at Check-In.

4. Schedule

- 4.1 Registration Friday July 5, from 9:00 to 12:00 hrs.
- 4.2 Competitors' briefing 12:00 hrs, Friday, July 5at the KYC Clubhouse.
- 4.3 Dates of racing July 5-6-7.
- 4.4 The number of races scheduled is 9.
- 4.5 The time scheduled for the warning for the first race is Friday July 5 at 13:30 hrs.
- 4.6 The scheduled time for the warning for the first race on Saturday is 11:00 hrs.
- 4.7 The scheduled time for the warning for the first race on Sunday is 10:00 hrs.
- 4.8 No warning signal will be displayed after 14:00 hrs on Sunday.
- 4.9 The awards ceremony will take place as soon as possible after the last race.

5. Venue

Racing will take place in Kingston Harbour, adjacent to KYC.

6. Sailing Instructions

Sailing instructions will be available at registration.

7. The Course

The course to be sailed will be as follows: windward-leeward with a gate and offset mark.

8. Scoring

- 8.1 One race is required to be completed to constitute a regatta.
- 8.2 When fewer than 5 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her races scores.
- 8.3 When 5 to 9 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.

9. Prizes

Keeper prizes will be awarded for the first through third place.

10. Social

The event will feature the following social functions:

- Class dinner Ticket included in entry fee
- BBQ evening featuring live music

11. Disclaimer of Liability

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during or after the regatta.

12. Insurance

Each participating boat shall be insured with third party liability insurance with a minimum cover of \$1,000,000 per event or equivalent for Canadian boats and US \$300,000 for American boats.
