FOOT Measurements

Symmetrical Spinnaker Notice

In order to prepare for the changes to how we will handicap Spinnakers in 2014, we will require foot measurements on all new Symmetrical Spinnakers reported during 2013.

If there is already a Symmetrical Spinnaker listed on a Certificate, we will default the size of the foot to equal the Max Girth. But, we recommend that all

Symmetrical Spinnaker foots be measured and reported as this "could" result in a reduction in size for 2014.

Centreline Tack Credit

All Spinnakers Notice

During the Spinnaker Area project it was identified that we needed to compensate for Spinnakers that are not tacked to either a Spinnaker pole or Articulating Bowsprit.

We have instituted a "Centreline Tack Credit" of +6 sec/nm when a boats only tack point for the Spinnaker is on the centreline.

For existing Certificates:

If you are an owner, please contact your club Handicapper to confirm that this should be applied to your certificate.

If you are a Handicapper, you need to notify the PHRF-LO office to ensure that the owners certificate is updated correctly.

For New Applications:

There is now a box on the application form under "FS Attachment" that reads:

Pole and/or Art BS Y N

In order to qualify for the "Centreline Tack Credit" you will have to mark this box as "No".

Central Council News

Handicapping Spinnakers

The big news is in the changes coming with regard to how we handicap Spinnakers. We have cleaned up some of the formula for 2013 and will be making some improvements in 2014 by instituting a sail area formula for calculating spinnaker size.
