A successful candidate should have an understanding of life cycle management of capital assets and will advise the manager of details of the club owned fleets. CANSail 5&6 coaching certifications and coaching experience are considered an asset. Employment lasts an extended season that starts 1 April and typically ends 31 Oct (dates negotiable).

### Successful candidates should have:

- Current Sail Canada Instructor Certification or equivalent qualification, with a minimum of one year instructing
- Current Sail Canada Instructor prerequisites (First Aid, CPR, PCOC, Boat Safety)
- Police Background Check (Vulnerable Sector Screening for the Junior Sailing program)
- Racing experience considered an asset
